

Photographic competition "Paparazzo" Rules and Regulation

The cultural association SMArt Academy, thanks to Regione Emilia Romagna, Provincia di Rimini, Comune di Rimini, Fondazione Fellini, calls a photographic competition, "Paparazzo", within the third edition of Amarcort Film Festival.

The term "paparazzo" became famous in Fellini's "La dolce vita".

The nowadays meaning of this term collides with the highest levels of photography, but Fellini's genial and smart ironic sense allows this contrast.

The theme of this first edition will be "la dolce vita": authors must not remain strictly related to the great movie by Fellini, but can let their creativity spread out in all the possible expressions inspired by this theme.

1. All photographers can participate paying a fee entry of 5,00 (five) euros.
Money can be send in the envelope together with the picture and the entry form completely filled.
2. Each photographer can send a maximum of 3 (three) pictures.
No photomontages and/or electronic processings to the pictures will be allowed.
All entrants must be able to supply a high resolution picture suitable for the printing of the catalogue.
3. To participate the authors must send a colour (and/or black&white and/or sepia) digital picture.
All files, in high resolution (minimum size 20X30 cm, maximum 30X40 cm), must be send on a CD specifying the subject "Concorso Fotografico Paparazzo".
All pictures must have name, surname and phone number of the author; they can also have a title and a description (40 characters maximum).
The 15 selected authors must provide their printed pictures at least 2 weeks before the Festival.
4. Each author:
 - Is responsible for the pictures he sends to the Festival.
 - Declares he is the only author of the pictures he sends to the Festival.
 - Assures the pictures he sends to the Festival don't violate any person's rights of privacy or publicity.
5. All pictures will be published on the Festival website at the url www.amarcort.it.
The pictures selected as finalists will be shown during the Festival and then authors can come to take them back.

6. A Grand Jury will choose the winning picture among the 15 selected.
The audience during the Festival will be able to vote for its favourite picture, and the picture that has gained more votes will win the Audience award, that will be assigned during the Festival.
7. Awards:
 - Paparazzo award – assigned by the Grand Jury (prize and money)
 - Audience award – mention to the most voted picture (prize)
8. Personal information will be held and used only for matters concerning the competition, in respect to the D.Leg.196/03.

10. The **deadline is May, 15th, 2010**. All envelopes must therefore be sent before that date. Amarcort staff is no responsible of any loss or damaging of the envelopes before their arrival.
11. **The decision of the Jury is final and no negotiation will be allowed and it will be announced during the Festival.**
Participating means the acceptance of all these rules.
12. **If required, rules and regulations can be modified by the organizing team at any time.**
